The Coy Honor Award originated in 1951 by F. Lawrence Coy who was the Associate Grand Guardian of Michigan at the time. Mr. Coy felt the need of encouragement to outstanding members. The purpose was to select a Daughter who had truly exemplified the teaching gained from the Story of Job. The intent of this award was to give all Daughters the opportunity of receiving this special recognition, regardless of holding a line office. Beginning at Grand Session 2017, we want to continue the recognition of the Coy Honor Award Recipient. The Daughter will be introduced during Escort, Introductions and Honors, in meetings, due to this honor. We hope this recognition continues.

It is the responsibility of the Bethel Guardian Council to select the Coy Nominee from their Bethel. The timeline and recommended procedure determined by the Coy Award Committee of the Grand Guardian Council should be followed. The nominee **should not be informed** of her nomination until it is announced **at Grand Session**.

Each Daughter nominated will receive a ribbon, which she may wear during Grand Session. The Daughter selected by the committee as the Coy Award recipient will receive a trophy. This is a year-long honor, and this is why we would like her to be introduced during Bethel Meetings. Her name will be engraved on the trophy. She will need to return this trophy after one year, and at which time she will receive a commemorative plaque.

The complete application should be mailed to the chairman of this committee by **JUNE 15th, 2018**. Deadlines are important. Since this is confidential, no email nominations will be accepted.
